In the summer of 1982, the Erie Motorcycle Club held a poker run in Meadville to see what kind of motorcycle interest was in the "Outback" of Crawford County. The turnout was tremendous, so with the help and encouragement of the Erie Motorcycle Club, a nucleus of approximately fifteen riders got together in early 1983 to form a non-marquee (no specific brand of motorcycle) club. From these humble beginnings, the Crawford County Road Riders Motorcycle Club has grown and prospered over the past 28 years to include forty-five members, many of who still ride weekly from April through November.

The club's first goal, then and now, was to bring kindred souls together to have FUN and RIDE. Over the years they have participated in every type of motorcycle road event, from local poker runs to long distance touring, featuring camping in distant states. From the beginning, they have been an American Motorcyclist Association (A.M.A.) chartered club in rides and charitable fundraisers.

Helping local organizations with worthwhile causes has been the second goal of the Crawford County

Road Riders. Local involvement would include, but is not limited to, the following:

- ◆ Make-A-Wish Foundation
- ◆ Donations to disaster victims
- ◆ Purchase & distribution of new toys for Christmas through the Salvation Army
- ◆ Donations to a local motorcycle accident victim
- ◆ Donations to Head Start

The club has riders from youth to older than dirt, both male and female. The bikes include old (vintage) and modern new bikes of many varieties: touring, sport, cruiser, sidecar and standard with engine sizes ranging from 250cc to 1800cc. The bikes come from a variety of countries, including the U. S., Japan, Britain, Italy, Germany and even Russia. Typical events held in any given year might include map runs, lime runs, observation runs, dice runs, poker runs and scavenger hunts. Breakfast runs (group ride) in the summer leave EVERY Sunday morning at 9:00 AM (Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day) from the Park Avenue Plaza. The rest of the year they leave at 9:30 AM from the same location. Saturday rides leave from Sheetz's

at 11:00 AM at the intersection of Routes 19, 322 & 98. The club also has overnight trips, club dinners, attending motorcycle races and getting together for the annual summer picnic.

If you own a motorcycle or just like to ride, why don't you join us at one of our monthly meetings and see what we are all about? We meet the first Wednesday of each month at 7:00 PM in the back room of Perkins Family Restaurant on Route 322 in Meadville. Come a little early and join us for dinner and some good conversation.
