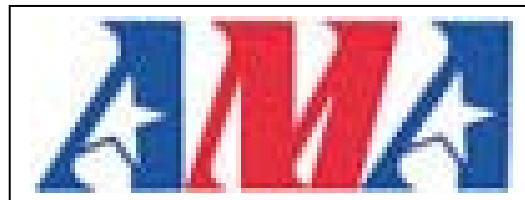

## Membership & Meetings:

Erie Motorcycle Club is chartered with the American Motorcyclist Association, District 5 covering Western Pennsylvania and West Virginia. Except for the club's officers, membership in the A.M.A. is not required but is encouraged. The annual dues are \$10.00 for a single and \$15.00 per couple.

The Erie Motorcycle Club meets the second Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM. Currently we're using the Social Hall in the basement of the Borough Hall in Edinboro. Weather permitting; a short club ride could be scheduled prior to or after the meeting.

## History:

Erie Motorcycle Club was first organized in 1929 and incorporated in 1946, a combination of two local area clubs once known as the Wolverines and Erie Motorcycle clubs. In 1982 the E.M.C. fostered the growth of "a sister" club in Meadville, the Crawford County Road Riders, still in existence today.

## About our Club:

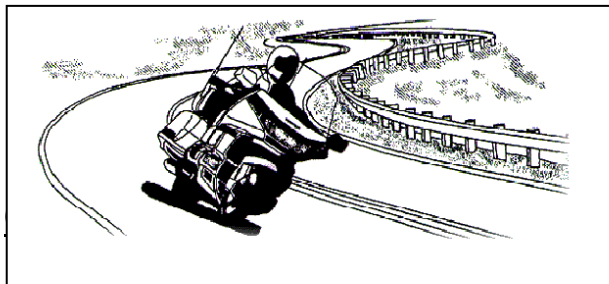
E.M.C.'s aim is to share the riding experience with motorcyclists by sponsoring various fund raisers like Poker, Lime, and Dice Runs, as well as other motorcycle related events in and around the Erie area. Our club is engaged in presenting a good public motorcycling image by supporting such organizations as the WQLN public TV and radio station, the Motorcycle Safety Foundation, and others. Some of our members are certified instructors that teach motorcycle safety in classes sponsored by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation. We also donate funds to local charities as determined by the membership.

## Club Activities:

We invite all motorcyclists who ride street legal machines to all of our public events which occur during the riding season, (usually April thru October.) Each run is advertised by various means such as an ad in the Erie Times News, Keystone Press, flyers and posters on display at Erie area cycle shops.

All events start at a location such as a local restaurant or coffee shop. A small entry fee is charged to cover the cost of prizes and expenses. You can compete in one of several classes determined by the number of entrants. Usually you'll be given a scorecard to record your results and route sheet to follow, but this may vary depending upon the type of event. You may be asked to perform a predetermined activity at the checkpoints along the route... like in the case of a Poker Run, draw a card, and prizes are awarded at the end of the event for the best Poker hand, Dice roll, etc. Run details, any last minute changes, safety tips, etc. are usually discussed prior to the event at the drivers meeting.

We also sponsor non-competitive events such as an occasional club ride or group outing.
